Please call City Hall to add your address to our pickup list. Only one pickup date per address please for residents living inside city limits. We ask you be considerate for mail delivery by not blocking any mail receptacles and for residential garbage pick up Friday Oct. 11th, keep items separate from the normal garbage bin.

- Scrap metal, appliances, mowers, lawn equipment
- Scrap wood and other miscellaneous household items
- Bicycles, lawn furniture, grills

NO hazardous waste, paints/solvents, tires, oil, T.V./electronics or yard waste/brush will be accepted. This is the perfect opportunity to clean out our cluttered spaces.
